 Little & John Little their heirs and assigns forever In Witnes whereof the said Willie Turner
 hath hereunto set his hand & seal this 25 day of March 1794

made this 11 day of June 1794 Between James Wilkinson of the coun-
 ty of Pen of the one part and John Boykin of the said county of the other Witnesseth that the said Wilkinson
 and in consideration of the sum of £350 & currency on hand paid by the said Wilkinson to the said
 Boykin who is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold & delivered by these presents with his
 alien profit & confirm unto the said John Boykin a certain tract of land & premises lying
 north side of Malabar River containing by Estimation 265 acres be the same more or less
 part of the land granted to William Whithead by Patent bearing date the 3^d of August
 same being bounded as followeth viz Beginning at a pine a corner of Mathews Win-
 thence a direct line to the drop Cut on Malabar river thence up the river course
 Run to an oak in the said John Boykins line thence along the said Boykins line to a
 Summers line in the Bear Marsh then to the little swamp thence along the river
 of the said swamp to the Beginning Together with every appurtenance thereunto
 To have and to hold the same to the proper use & behoof of him the said Boykin in
 and the said Wilkinson doth for himself his heirs & assigns warrant & defend the title of
 said land & premises against all & every person or persons who shall soever In Witnes
 whereof the said Wilkinson hath hereon set his hand & affixed his seal this day & year
