This Indenture made this Tenth day of June 1798 Between William Thomas of the county of Southampton & State of Virg^a of the one part & George Gurley Sr^t of the county of State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Thomas for and in consideration of the sum of £68.15 to him in hand paid by the said George Gurley Sr^t hath given granted & by these presents doth give grant & confirm unto the said George Gurley Sr^t his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the county of State aforesaid containing by Estimation 137¹/₂ acres which land is the half of a patent obtained by Henry Thomas bearing date the 16 day of August 1756 & divided between the s^r Henry Thomas & Jeremiah Ellis by a dividing line agreed on between the parties in their lifetime & which land ever since the death of Henry Thomas the s^r William Thomas has held in quiet possession in right of his father which land & tenement together with all buildings improvements & fixtures meadows & profits advantages rents & profits reversion & remainders & all other advantages arising on or pertaining to the said premises & every part & parcel thereof the said W^m Thomas doth by these presents give grant make over & confirm in fee simple unto the said George Gurley Sr^t his heirs & assigns forever and the said William Thomas for himself his heirs the above mentioned land & premises & every part & parcel thereof unto the said George Gurley Sr^t his heirs & assigns forever shall bind warrant & forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof he hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day & year above written

This Indenture made this 13 day of June in the year 1798 Between Mary Powell & William Jewell of the county of Sta and State of Virginia of the one part & Joshua Claus of the county of Sussex of the other part Witnesseth that the said Mary Powell for the consideration of the sum of £3.15 Current money of Virg^a to them in hand paid by the said Joshua Claus the receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain & sold unto the said Joshua Claus & confirm by these presents for them & their heirs doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Joshua Claus his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land lying & being situate in the county aforesaid bounded as follows Beginning at three white oaks in the Church Bottom next to the s^r Jewell's & following the mill run thence up the drain to the road then to a black oak on the other side the Road thence
