A court held for the county of Sten the 10 day of July 1794 — This Indenture and the receipt thereon ~~was~~ ^{were} proved by the oath of John Darden Catching's Council & David Johnson the witnesses thereto acknowledged by the said Fanny Bracey she being first Privily Examined as the Law directs and ordered to be recorded

This Indenture Tripartite made this 28th day of June Anno Dom 1794 Between Littleton Scholar, James Woodson, Henry Woodson, Bob Wincok, Jimmy Wincok, Tom Tanna, Lucy Roger, in Tanna, Navy Woodson, Betty Top, and Nanny Wolf for ourselves & in behalf of Mr. Paul R. to Nanny Tanna who are about & in behalf of Mr. Top & Ann Woodson infants & of the Nottoway Blue Tribe of Indians of the first Part & James Wilkinson Thomas Vaughan James Miller John Taylor Delic Thomas Ridley & Robert Goodwyn Gent trustees as herein after mentioned of the second part and John Tho. Blaw Lord of the county of Southampton of the third part Witnesseth that whereas by act of the General Assembly of Virg^a Intituled an act concerning the Nottoway tribe of Indians passed the 12th day of November anno dom 1792 James Wilkinson John Tho. Blaw Lord. Tho. Vaughan John Taylor Thomas Ridley & Robert Goodwyn Gent were appointed Trustees for the said Indians and by the said act was authorized lawful for the said Tribe of Indians under the direction & with the approbation of the said Trustees or any two of them to sell upon 12 Mo credit a tract of land lying in the said county which had been laid out to certain persons in the year 1772 and which lease was about to expire in the year 1793 and upon such sale the said trustees or any two of them were authorized and empowered to join the said Indians in conveying the same to the purchaser as purchasers in fee And this Indenture witnesseth that the said Indians who are James Wilkinson Thomas Vaughan James Miller John Taylor Tho. Ridley & Robert Goodwyn Gent trustees as aforesaid joining with the said Indians for and in consideration of the sum of £18 current money to be paid to the said Trustees or their Successors by the said John Tho. Blaw Lord & for the payment whereof the said John Tho. Blaw Lord hath given bond with appraisers & security pursuant to the above recited act have bargained & sold alien & confirmed & by these presents do bargain & sell alien & confirm to the said John Tho. Blaw Lord his mentions in the above recited act containing by estimation 734 Acres & bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at a pine in the Indian back line a corner of N. & E. thence along a line of marked trees North 25 degrees E 80 poles to a Hickory thence North 6 degrees West 162 poles to a red oak thence North 23 degrees E 48 poles to a Birch thence on the south side of Nottoway River thence up the River to an overcup white oak tree standing on the bank of the said river & running South 43 West 15 poles to a Poplar
