

Take of Indians under the direction and with the approbation of the s^d Trustees or any five of them to sell upon Twelve months credit a tract of land lying in the s^d county which had been deeded to certain persons in the year 1772 and which lease was about to expire in the year 1793 Upon such sale the s^d Trustees or any five of them were authorized & empowered to join the s^d Indians in conveying the same to the purchaser or purchasers in fee Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Indians and the said James Wilkinson Tho^s Vaughan James Miller John Taylor John Thomas Blow & Rob^t Goddard Gent trustees as aforesaid joining with these Indians for and in consideration of the sum of £2007. 5.8 to be paid to the said Trustees or their Successors by the said Thomas Ridley and for the payment whereof the said Thomas Ridley hath given bond with approved security pursuant to the above recited act have bargain'd & sold alien'd and confirm'd, & by these presents do bargain & sell alien and confirm to the said Thomas Ridley his heirs and assigns forever one tract or parcel of land being a part of the above said tract of Land mentioned in the above recited act containing by Estimation 448 acres & bounded as follow Viz^t Beginning at a Persimmon in the Beaver dam branch thence North 25 degrees East 435 Poles to a pine thence North 45 deg West 228 poles to three pines thence South 7 degrees West 244 poles to a red Oak North 49 degrees West 215 poles to a black Gum in the Spring branch then South 17 degrees West to a stake in the head of Robins branch thence down Robins branch to the Beaver dam branch & up the various courses of the said branch to the Beginning together with all profits & advantages hereditaments & appurtenant whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of land in any wise belonging To have & hold the said tract of land to the said Thomas Ridley to him & his heirs forever and the said Indians for themselves and their posterity the said tract of Land & premises against themselves & their posterity & against all & every other person & persons whatsoever to the said Tho^s Ridley and his heirs forever by these presents do and shall warrant and forever defend and the said trustees the said tract of land and premises against themselves and against all & every other person or persons claiming under them or any of them to the said Thomas Ridley and his heirs by these presents do and shall warrant and forever defend In testimony whereof we the parties to these presents have hereunto set our hands and affix'd our seals the day and year first above said
