This Indenture made this 6th day of June in the year of our Lord Christ 1794 Between Howell Briggs and Susannah his wife of the county of Southampton & parish of Netoway of the one part & James Bell of the same county and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Howell Briggs & Susannah his wife for and in consideration of the just & full sum of £19 current money of England to them then and to the said Howell Briggs & Susannah his wife in hand paid by the said James Bell at or before the underwriting and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Howell Briggs & Susannah his wife do hereby acknowledge and thereof & therefrom doth acquit & discharge the said James Bell his heirs and assigns forever and themselves therewith fully & entirely satisfied & contented & praise they the said Howell Briggs & Susannah his wife have granted bargain sold & have conveyed release set our deliver & confirm & by these presents doth grant bargain sell & have conveyed release set our deliver & confirm unto the said James Bell and to his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract and parcel of land situate lying & being in the county & parish aforesaid containing by Estimation 100 Acres (more or less) and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a great pine standing by the side of the Mill path thence a cross the said path along the dividing line between Elizabeth Moore and the land sold by Howell Briggs to James Bell to a Black jack oak thence to a pine in the said line thence along the said line to a red oak thence along the said line to a post oak thence along the said line to a black jack oak thence along the said line to a large pine standing at the head of a small branch thence to a pine in the said branch thence down the various corners of the said branch to the run of the village to the said Village branch thence up the said small branch near the head to a poplar in the said branch where said poplar makes into the D branch thence up the said path to a pine at the head of the said branch along line of new marked trees the dividing line between the D branch
