This Indenture made this 12th day of March 1794 Between W^m Macky of the county of Sta & Va and blacky to of Nottingham of the one part & Thomas Jynor & James Chappell of the county & Parish of St & Va of the other part Whereas the said Thomas Jynor & James Chappell did at the request of the s^r W^m Macky become bound with him to John Denson & Company & Sethia Trade in the consideration of the just & full sum of thirty eight pounds fifteen shillings & two pence current money of England and interest growing due thereon and it is but reasonable that the said Thomas Jynor & James Chappell should be secured from all damage that may arise from their becoming bound to the s^r W^m Macky's security & Jynor & Now this indenture witnesseth that for securing & saving himself the said Thomas Jynor & James Chappell from all damage that may happen arise accrue or be due either of them by means of their being security for the s^r W^m Macky as aforesaid & also for the consideration of the just & full sum of £38 15 s to the said W^m Macky in hand paid by the said Thomas Jynor & James Chappell at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said W^m Macky with Henry Ackers & Co & there acquit & discharge the s^r W^m Macky
