This Indenture made this 11th day of Sept in the year of our Lord Christ 1794 Between
 Arthur Turner & Anne his wife of the county of Southampton of the one part and John Blunt
 of the said county of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of £ 50⁰
 current money of Virginia to the said Arthur Turner & Anne his wife in hand paid by the said
 John Blunt or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the
 said Arthur Turner & Anne his wife doth hereby acknowledge & thereof & every part thereof
 doth promise to and acquit the said John Blunt his heirs & assigns forever
