This Indenture made this 17th day of Feb^y in the year of our Lord 1794 Between Thomas Willford of the county of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part & Britain Bryant of the same county of the other part whereas the said Tho Willford stands Justly Indebted unto the s^d Britain Bryant in the Just sum of £20 current money of Virg^a & being willing to secure the payment of the same to the s^d Britain Bryant This Indenture witnesseth that the said Tho Willford for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings by the said Britain Bryant to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge & for the securing the payment of the said sum of Twenty pounds hath bargained & sold & by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Britain Bryant his heirs & assigns one negro boy named Ned To have & to hold the s^d Negro to the said Britain Bryant his heirs & assigns forever but upon this expressed proviso in Trust & confidence for the s^d Tho Willford that he the said Britain Bryant shall make sale of the Negro any time after the 1st day of Sep^r next Next of the money arising from the sale first to pay & satisfy the above sum & after discharging the said debt to pay the balance unto the s^d Tho Willford his heirs & assigns or assigns and the Tho Willford for himself his heirs & assigns doth Grant agree with the s^d Britain Bryant that he shall have a claim to the said Negro according to his agreement unto the said Britain Bryant his heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof The Parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands & seals the day & year above written
