This Indenture made this 29 day of July in the year of our Lord Christ 1794 Britain
Blake Benjamin Blake of the county of Southampton & Parish of St Lukes of the one part & Henry
to Barrow of the aforesaid county & Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin
Barrow carried to Blake for and in consideration of the sum of £120 of good lawful money of King's to him in
Feb^r 7th 1795 hand paid on or before the sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said
Benj^a Blake doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain'd sold alien'd & confirm'd
unto the said Henry Barrow and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel
of land containing 155 Acres it being part of a Patent granted the said Blake bearing
date the 29 day of Nov^r 1789 and bounded as follow to wit Beginning at a white oak a corner
in John Blakes & Henry Barrow other line thence a long John Blakes line to the Anglica
Swamp thence up the run of the said Swamp to a Maple in Edwin blaunders line thence
North Forty six degrees East 18 Poles along blaunders line then North 58 degrees East 16 Poles
to a corner pine between the said Blake John Barrow & W^m blaunders then North 9 degrees
East 76 Poles to a pine corner of John Barrows line then North 8 degrees East 58 Poles
an Oak in the run of Blakes Mill Swamp also another corner of John Barrows land
then East 88 Poles to a bend in the Mill Swamp then North 54 degrees West 12 Poles to a pine
then North 14 degrees West 32 Poles to a large pine thence North 20 degrees West 103 Poles to
a white oak thence to the Beginning containing 155 acres more or less to have & to hold the
said 155 acres Land with all & singular the appurtenances unto the said Henry Barrow
Henry Barrow his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use behoof & the Barrow
Barrow his heirs and assigns forever & the said Benj^a Blake doth for himself his heirs
covenant & agree with the said Henry Barrow his heirs & assigns that the said Benjamin
Blake his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend the above mentioned
Lands & premises unto the said Henry Barrow his heirs & assigns forever against the
claim or title of all person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the said Benjamin Blake
hereunto set his hand affixed his seal the day & year above written
