This Indenture made this the 8th day of May in the year of our Lord 1794 between
 Charles Speed & his wife Jemmy Speed of the county of Ston^r Parish of Malloway of the one part
 & Henry Bulls of the other part of the same county & Parish Witnesseth that the said
 Speed & wife Jemmy Speed for and in consideration of the sum of fifty two pounds current
 money of Eng^l to them in hand paid by the said Henry Bulls at or before the executing &
 delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said Charles Speed & wife Jemmy
 Speed doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said
 Henry Bulls his Exors and Amors forever they the said Charles Speed
 and Jemmy Speed hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed confirmed
 & by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff & confirm unto the said
 Henry Bulls his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land lying & being
 in the aforesaid county of Ston^r containing 103 Acres more or less bounded as follows
 to wit Beginning at a pine in Edmund Tylers old line thence along line of maple
 trees to pine a corner of the said Tylers line & to a line of John Wrights thence
 by the said Wrights line to a pine by the side of a branch called Son ash branch
 thence up the said branch to a small branch to a white oak in John Bennets
 line thence along the s^d Bennets line to a pine a corner tree of a new dividing line
 of Lemuel Inles thence along the s^d line to the first Station & all buildings & other
 tenes Waters profits hereditaments & appurtenances to the said land belonging & the succession
 & reversion remainder & remainders rents & profits thereof & of every part thereof the
 have and to hold the said land & premises with the appurtenances unto the said
 Henry Bulls his heirs & assigns to the only proper use & behoof of the s^d Henry
 Bulls his heirs & assigns forever and the said Charles Speed & his wife Jemmy
 Speed for themselves & their heirs do agree to warrant and forever defend the
 title of the said land & premises aforesaid to the said Henry Bulls against
 them the said Charles Speed & Jemmy Speed or any person or persons what
 soever claiming under them In Witness whereof they have hereunto set their
