This Indenture made this 2nd day of July in the year of our Lord Christ 1794.
Between William Edmunds & Humphrey Duryas Trustees appointed by an order of May
to court 1794 to sell a certain tract or parcel of land belonging to the orphans of Jeremiah
Drew dec'd it being a tract of land the said Drew purchas'd of Tho^s Bland dec'd
of the county of Southampton and parish of St Lukes of the one part and Henry Barrow of the
aforesaid county & parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Edmunds & Humphrey
Duryas and in the consideration of the sum of Sixty Pounds one shilling & three pence good
and lawfull money of Vng^a the receipt whereof we the said William Edmunds & Humphrey
Duryas do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain'd & sold a certain & certain unto
the said Henry Barrow and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel
of land situate lying & being in the county & parish aforesaid and on the south side
of the Three Creeks and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a red oak corner
in John Barrows line thence along the s^d line to the head of a short branch then down
the said branch to Purdeys branch thence up the run of the said Purdeys branch to the
Mouth Woffitt Meadow thence up the said Meadow to three Persimmon Trees near
the head of the said Meadow a corner of John Blakes George Stephensons & the land
herein mention'd thence along John Blakes line to Benjamin Blakes line thence
along Benj^m Blakes line to the beginning containing 112 Acres as by estimation
more or less To have and to hold the said 112 Acres of land with all & singular the
appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Henry Barrow his heirs & assigns
forever to the only proper use & behoof of the said Henry Barrow his heirs & assigns
