or less it being part of a patent granted to Samuel Westbrook bearing date the 15 day of Nov^r
1741 with all singulars to the said William Bynum his heirs & assigns forever & the said
Matthew Figuers & Mary his wife for themselves their heirs & do acknowledge themselves
fully satisfied & do hereafter warrant & defend the said premises In witness whereof
they have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals this day & year above written.

1798 Between Mary Pope of the Place aforesaid of the one part & Jonathan Wilson of the same
Place of the other part Witnesseth that the said Mary Pope for and in consideration
of the condition & agreement undermentioned on the part & behalf of the s^d Jonathan
Wilson his heirs & assigns to be done kept & performed hath leased to the said
Jonathan Wilson 40 Acres of Land & bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a pine in
William Hick's line thence along the said Hick's line to a lightwood stump a corner
of Edmund Barnetts thence along the said Barnetts line to a pine in the said Barnetts
line thence a line of marked trees to the beginning with full Privileges to clear and
cultivate the s^d 40 Acres of land & enjoy all profits arising therefrom from the day
the date hereof until the decease of the said Mary Pope & the s^d Jonathan Wilson
on his part doth promise & agree in consideration of the above Privileges to pay
the taxes of the said land as long as he has it in possession In witness whereof
the s^d Mary Pope has unchangeably set her hand & affixed her
