This Indenture made this 27th day of October in the year of our Lord 1794 between Richard
Williams of Virg^a and county of Prin of the one part & Jordan Williams of the same county & late partner
to the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Williams for and in consideration of the sum of \$
lawful money of Virg^a to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Jordan Williams
thenceforth the said Richard Williams doth hereby acquit and discharge hath granted bargain sold & conveyed
Release & confirm & by these doth fully & absolutely grant bargain sell by these doth confirm unto the
aforesaid Jordan Williams his heirs & assigns all that Plantation tract or parcel of land that the said
Jordan Williams now lies on lying along on the North side of Potomac River in the county of Prince
George containing 140 Acres be the same more or less bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine standing
in the Potomac on the side of Potomac River a small distance above Jones Ferry thence running about
North west course to a black gum standing on the edge of the Potomac thence out of the Potomac a small
distance to a pine thence running up the Potomac to a red oak a corner tree thence running about North
course to a Red oak standing on the east side of the great swamp near the mouth of a branch
a corner tree thence running up the side of the said branch along a line of marked trees to a
standing on the east side of the said branch a corner tree thence running up the side of the said
branch along a line of marked trees to a white oak John Goodins corner tree thence running along the
side of the said branch along a line of marked trees to a pine standing in John Goodins line a
corner tree thence running about a west course along a line of marked trees made for that purpose
to a Hickory standing on a ridge near the river thence running the said course to the river
a small distance above the said Jordan Williams's Spring Place thence running down the
various courses of the river to the first station Together with all houses & buildings & their
with the divisions & divisions & remains as unto them & their heirs & assigns with all
part & parcel thereof with the appurtenances To have & to hold the said bargain & premises with all
rights & profits & privileges & appurtenances to the said Jordan Williams his heirs & assigns with all
