This Indenture made the 21st of Nov^r 1794 Between William Cricklow of the county of St^r & parish of Muttonay of the one part & John Cricklow of the county of Warwick of the other part witnesseth that the said Will^m Cricklow for and in consideration of the sum of £500000 money of his Majesty's lawful tender paid by the said John Cricklow the receipt whereof the said Will^m Cricklow hereby acknowledging he the said Will^m Cricklow hath granted bargained & sold a piece of land situate in the parish of Muttonay to the said John Cricklow his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation 300 acres be the same measured by purchase of Daniel Simmons from John Simmons & Anne his wife by Indenture bearing date the 13th day of January 1786. Recorded in the county court of St^r & bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning on the Apsomock swamp thence up the main run of the said swamp to the mouth of the sweat house branch to a red oak a little beyond the mouth thereof thence a long beamed Denny's line to a pine in a small branch thence down the said branch to a gum thence along Indian line to a red oak thence along line of new marked trees to the beginning and also all trees & wood & underwood common of Pastures profits commodities advantages & emoluments hereunto in any way appertaining or upon the same growing happening or arising & also the division & divisions & remains & rents & services of the said premises & of every part thereof and also all the estate right title Interest claim & demand whatsoever of from the said Will^m Cricklow for & his heirs & assigns & every part thereof To have and to hold all & singular the premises above mentioned & every part thereof with the appurtenances to the said John Cricklow his heirs & assigns forever & the said Will^m Cricklow for him & his heirs the said tract of Land & every part of parcel thereof against his heirs & assigns & all & every other person & persons whatsoever the said John Cricklow his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said William Cricklow hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day & year above written
