This Indenture made the 25<sup>th</sup> of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1794 Between William Cucklow of the county of St<sup>r</sup> &  
parish of Nettway of this part & John Cucklow of the county & Parish afores<sup>t</sup> on the other part witnesseth  
that the said Willm Cucklow for and in consideration of the sum of £5 current money of Eng<sup>t</sup> to him  
had paid by the said John Cucklow the receipt whereof the said Willm Cucklow hereby acknowledging  
he the said Willm Cucklow hath granted bargained & sold alioin Enpoff'd by these presents  
grant bargain sell all in Enpoff'd Yorson unto the said John Cucklow his heirs & assigns from  
one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation 300 acres be the same meadow or  
purchasid by Daniel Simmons from John Fishamore & Anne his wife by Indenture bearing date the

13<sup>th</sup> day of January 1786 Recorded in the county court of St<sup>r</sup> & hundred as follows with twenty  
Beginning on the Agarwood swamp thence up the main run thereof to the mouth  
of the sweat house branch to a red oak a little beyond the mouth thereof there a long laurel  
Dawys line to a pine in a small branch thence down this<sup>t</sup> branch to a gum thence along this  
line to red oak thence along line of new marked trees to the beginning and also all trees wood under  
commons common of Pastures profits commodities advantages & emoluments hereabouts  
whatever to the said tract or parcel of land above mentioned belonging or in any wise appertaining  
or upon the same growing happening or arising & also the river & brooks in manner  
remained unto & service of the said promisee of every part thereof and also all the estate  
right title interest claim demand whatsoever of him the said Willm Cucklow for & to the said  
promisee of every part thereof to have and to hold all & singular the premises above mentioned  
every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said John Cucklow his heirs & assigns from &  
Willm Cucklow to him & his heirs the said tract of Land & every part of parcel thereto adjacent  
his heirs against all & way other person or persons whatsoever, the said John Cucklow his heirs  
and assigns shall & will warrant & power defend by these presents In witness whereof  
said Willm Cucklow hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day & year  
above written

whereas after mention of the one part Wm Cucklow of the county of St<sup>r</sup> of the other part  
witnesseth that whereas an act of the General Assembly of Eng<sup>t</sup> passed Dec<sup>r</sup> the 7<sup>th</sup> 1790 which  
did an act to establish certain Towns and other purposes hath enacted that no acre or plant  
adjoining the Courthouse in the county of St<sup>r</sup> the property of Joseph Hill Scott should be used
