

This Indenture Testate made this 13 day of June Anno Domini 1791 between  
 Littleton Schollar James Woodson Henry Woodson Bob Wincoak Jimmy Wincoak Tom  
 Turner Lucy Roge Ely Turner Manny Woodson Manny Wott Betty Hob for our selves  
 and for and in behalf of William Gabriel and Manny Turner who are about 1/2 and in  
 behalf of Solomon Rep Ann Woodson &c. & Infants of the Nottoway Tribe of Indians  
 of the first part and James Wilkinson Thomas Vaughan James Miller John Taylor John  
 Thomas Blow Thomas Ridley Robert Goodwyn Gentlemen Trustees as herein after men-  
 tioned of the second part & Samuel Blunt of the county of Southampton of the third  
 part Witnesseth that whereas by an act of General Assembly of Virginia intituled  
 an act concerning the Nottoway Tribe of Indians passed the 12 day of November  
 Anno Domini 1792 James Wilkinson John Thomas Blow son of Thomas Vaughan  
 Thomas Edmunds John Taylor Thomas Ridley and Robert Goodwyn Gentlemen were  
 appointed Trustees for the said Indians and by the said act was rendered lawful for  
 the said Tribe of Indians under the direction & with the approbation of the said  
 Trustees or any five of them to sell upon Twelve months Credit a tract of land lying  
 in the said county which had been leased to certain Persons in the year 1772 and  
 which lease was about to expire in the year 1793 Upon such sale the said Trustees  
 or any five of them were authorized & empowered to join the said Indians in con-  
 veying the same to the purchaser or purchasers in fee Now This Indenture witness-  
 eth that the said Indians & the said J<sup>r</sup> Wilkinson Thomas Vaughan J<sup>r</sup> Miller  
 John Taylor John Thomas Blow Thomas Ridley & Robert Goodwyn Gentlemen trustees as  
 aforesaid joining with the said Indians for and in consideration of the sum of Three  
 Hundred & Ninety Nine Pounds one Shilling to be paid to the said Trustees or their success-  
 ors by the said Samuel Blunt Upon the Payment whereof the said J<sup>r</sup> Samuel Blunt hath given  
 Bond with approved Sureties pursuant to the above recited Act have bargained & sold  
 aliened and confirmed by these presents as bargain & sell alien confirm to the said  
 Samuel Blunt his heirs & assigns forever one tract or parcel of land being a part of the  
 above said tract of land mentioned in the above recited act containing by Estimation  
 Four hundred & fifty eight acres & bounded as follows Viz Beginning at a Hickory  
 Tree in the edge of Low Grounds on the western side of Buckhorn swamp oppo-  
 site the mouth of the Beaverdam branch thence up the run of the S<sup>e</sup> branch to the mouth  
 of Robins branch thence up Robins branch to a Stake in the head thence thence North 17  
 degrees East 100 poles to a Gum in the Spring branch South 49 degrees East 25 poles to an  
 oak thence North 17 degrees East 24 1/2 poles to three pines thence North west 2 1/2 poles to an  
 red oak thence South 17 degrees East 165 poles to a black Gum thence North 42 degrees  
 West 72 Poles to a Gum in a small fork of a branch thence down the S<sup>e</sup> branch to the  
 Oakley branch thence down the run of the said branch to Buckhorn swamp & across the same  
 to a Willow oak Tree in the edge of the low Grounds thence up the edge of the low Grounds  
 of the aforesaid Swamp to the beginning together with all Profits advantages here-  
 allments & appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land in any wise belonging  
 to have and to hold the said tract of land to the said Samuel Blunt to him his heirs
