This Indenture made this 7 day of January 1795. Between Nathan Poole of
the county of Southampton of the one part & John Whitehead of the county of Isle of Wight
and another part witnesseth that the s^r Nathan Poole & his wife Eliz^r for an consideration
of the sum of Two hundred pounds current money of Virginia to him and hand paid by the said
John Whitehead before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof the s^r Nathan Poole this
wife Eliz^r doth acknowledge and therefore doth acquit and discharge the said J^r Whitehead his
heirs Executors Administrators and assigns by these presents and therefore doth grant bargain
and sell almane & infoflempson unto the said John Whitehead his heirs Executors
Administrators and assigns one certain Tract or parcel of land lying & being in the aforesaid
Southampton County bounded as follows vizt Beginning at two Ashes to the
side of the Whitewood swamp thence W^{ards} by N^o. 4th Pole to a Gum by the side of
W^{ards} branch thence up the various courses of the branch to a pine thence
long a line of mark'd trees to a pine thence to a red oak from thence to a hickory
the line of Charles Poole's deed thence along the said Poole's line to a white Oak by the
side of the Whitewood swamp aforesaid and down the run of the said swamp to the
first Station it being the felle bounds of Patent Granted Crocker bearing date
the 20th day of September 1745 containing by estimation 250 Rods more or less
To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land & premises during but
