This Indenture made this 7 day of January 1795. Between Nathan Porter of the county of Southampton of the one part & John Whitehead of the county of Isle of Wight and another part Witnesseth that the s^d. Nathan Porter his wife Eliza for an in consideration of the sum of Two hundred pounds current money of Virginia to him and her paid by the said John Whitehead before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof the s^d. Nathan Porter his wife Eliza both acknowledge and therefore both acquit and discharge the said John Whitehead his heirs heirs assigns and assigns by those presents and therefore doth grant bargain and sell alienable & possessible unto the said John Whitehead his heirs heirs assigns and assigns an certain Tract or parcel of land lying & being in the aforesaid Southampton County bounded as follows to wit Beginning at two acres by the side of the Whitewood swamp thence W by N 48° Pole to a Gum by the side of White branch thence up the various courses of the branch to a pine thence long a line of marked trees to a pine thence to a red oak from thence to a line on the line of Charles Porters dead thence along the said Porters line to a white Oak by the side of the Whitewood Swamp aforesaid and down the run of the said swamp to the first Station it being the full bounds of Patent granted Crocker bearing date the 20th day of September 1745 containing by Estimation 250 Acres more or less To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land & Premises unto the said John Whitehead his heirs heirs assigns and assigns forever with the appurtenances thereof belonging unto the said John Whitehead his heirs heirs assigns and assigns forever and the said Nathan Porter for himself his heirs heirs assigns and assigns forever
