This Indenture made this 9th day of December in the year of our Lord Christ 1794 between Robert Carr of the county of Southampton & State of Virg^a of the one part & Will^m Pope of the county and State afores^d of the other part Witnesseth that the s^d Robert Carr for & in consideration of the sum of ten dollars current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the s^d William Pope the receipt whereof the said Robert Carr doth hereby acknowledge they the said Robert Carr have granted & bargain'd & sold alien'd & confirm'd & by these presents do grant bargain & sell alien & confirm unto the said William Pope his heirs & assigns forever one part tract or parcel of land situate lying upon the South side of Nottingham River in the counties of Southampton & aforesaid containing by estimation ^{more or less} & to be the same more or less & bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a Maple in the Grassy branch then down the said branch 12 poles to Crossed Road thence down said Road 75 poles to a lightwood Post standing presently there thence nearly a N West course along my lane 14 poles to a lightwood Post in the Indian line thence up the Indian line to the beginning & also the American Reservation is made in the said premises & the said premises & every part thereof shall be the Estate Right title Interest claim & demand whatsoever of him the s^d Robert Carr & to the said real tract or parcel of land every part thereof to have and to hold the said real tract or parcel of land and all singular the premises above mentioned survey part & parcel being with the appurtenances unto the said William Pope his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof of the said William Pope his heirs & assigns forever & the s^d Robert Carr for himself & his heirs the said real tract or parcel of land & premises every part thereof against him his heirs & assigns against all & every person persons whatsoever to the s^d William Pope his heirs & assigns shall and lawfully warrant & defend & hold by these presents in witness whereof the s^d Robert Carr hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & year above written
