This Indenture made this 27th day of December in the year of our Lord 1795 Between Elisha Kindred and Susanna his wife of the county of Devon State of North Carolina of the one part and Benjamin Blunt of Southampton county State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred & fifteen pounds three shillings Virginia currency to them in hand paid the receipt whereof they the said Elisha Kindred & Susanna his wife have granted bargain'd & sold by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Benjamin Blunt and to his heirs from one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the county of Southampton State aforesaid containing by estimation One hundred & one acres & is bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning on Cross Swamp at the mouth of W. Kindreds long branch thence up the various courses of the run of said branch to a black gum stump with three sprouts in the head thence North 29 degrees East 134 Poles to a pine in the head of the long branch thence South 82 degrees West to the run of the aforesaid Cross Swamp thence down the various courses of the run of the said Swamp to the beginning together with all houses orchards woods ways waters & with courses Privileges Hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appurtenant To have and to hold the said granted land and premises to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Boye Blunt his heirs from & to the said Elisha Kindred & Susanna his wife doth for themselves & their Executors or assigns covenant & agree to & with the said Benjamin Blunt that they the said Elisha Kindred & Susanna his wife shall & will forever hereafter Warrant & defend the right title of the aforesaid granted land & premises to the said Benjamin Blunt and to his heirs from against the right title or interest of all & every person & persons whomsoever In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands & affixed our seals the day & year first above written
