Christ 1795. Between William Ward of the county of Isle of Wight of the one part
and Richard Beal of the county of Southampton Parish of Nettoway of the other part
witnesseth that the said William Ward for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty
one pounds six Shillings & seven pence current money of Virginia already in hand
paid them by the said Richard Beal at and before the sealing & delivery of these pre
sents therewith whereof the said William Ward doth hereby acknowledge and himself
thereof entirely satisfied & contented and paid have bargain & sold alone & separate
and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain sell alien assign
and confirm unto the said Richard Beal his heirs & assigns forever one certain
tract or parcel of land lying & being situate in the county of Southampton
and parish of Nettoway and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at the
Head of Rogers branch on Hardy Johnsons line thence along a line from
trees to Thomas Lous line thence along Lous line to a Sighwood Posts line
true & thence along Lous line till by a line of marked trees to the House line
branch thence down the said branch to a Maple in Littleberry Lous
line and from thence along a line of marked trees to the first Pole line and
