Christ 1795. Between William Ward of the county of Isle of Wight of the one part  
and Richard Beale of the county of Southampton parish of Notloway of the other part witnesseth  
that the said William Ward for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty  
one pounds six shillings & seven pence current money of Virginia already in his  
paid them by the said Richard Beale at and before the sealing hereof doth  
unto the receipt whereof the said William Ward doth hereby acknowledge and bound  
himself entirely satisfied contented and paid have bargained sold alienated willed  
and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain sell alienate  
and confirm unto the said Richard Beale his heirs & assigns forever one certain  
tract or parcels of land lying & being situate in the county of Southampton  
and parish of Notloway and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at the  
head of Roger's branch on Hardy Johnson's line thence along a line found  
trees to Thomas Lovell's line thence along Lovell's line to a lightwood, <sup>larch</sup>  
tree & thence along Lovell's line west by a line of mark'd trees to the house house  
branch thence down the said branch to a Maple in Littlebury Lands  
line and from thence along a line of mark'd trees to the first station and
