

This Indenture made this 10th day of Decr in the year of our Lord 1793 Between The Cullum of Sussex county of the one part & John Wall of Southampton County of the other part Witneith that the said Thomas Cullum for an inconsideration of the sum of £5.14 cash to him in hand paid by the said John Wall the receipt whereof the said Thomas Cullum doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold unto the said John Wall his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing 9 Acres & 2¹/₂ lying in Fern County bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a white oak on the road a corner tree of John Knight on Richard Clements line thence along the said Clements line to a white oak on the said Cullum line thence by a new line North East course to a white oak on said road thence along said road to the Beginning with all the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said tract or parcel of land also the estate right title Interest claim and demand whatsoever of the said Thomas Cullum of in or the same premises and every part thereof to have hold carry part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said John Wall his heirs & assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said John Wall his heirs forever and the said Thomas Cullum for himself his heirs the said premises and every part thereof containing against him his heirs and against all and every other person & persons whatsoever to the said John Wall his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant & firm defend by these presents In Witneis whereof the said Thomas Cullum have set my hand and affixed my seal the day & date above written
