This Indenture made this 15th day of December in the year of our Lord 1794 Between Thomas Turner and Patience Turner his wife of Southampton county in Virginia of the one part & John Rogers of the county of Wake and state of North Carolina of the other part Witness that the said Thomas Turner & Patience his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds Virginia currency to them in hand paid by the said John Rogers the receipt whereof is duly acknowledged hath granted bargain'd sold alien'd & confirm'd & confirmed by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said John Rogers his heirs or assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the county of Southampton on the North side of Meherrin River containing fifty acres the same more or less except the right and dower of Martha Baile his daughter John Baile's wife which she doth lawfully hold during her natural life &c Also Two thirds of the Orchard of Appletrees which are reserved to the use and benefit of the said Tho^s Turner his heirs or assigns so long as he said trees shall last which said tract of land is bounded as follows Beginning at a pine near the fish path in John Baile's old line thence along line of John Baile's line to Drury Harris's line thence along the said Drury Harris's & Baile's old line to James Harris's deed line thence along the said James Harris's line to a pine a corner of Baile's Baile's Baile's & said John Rogers's land thence along said Rogers's & Baile's old line down the said Fish road to the beginning To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land except as above with all the appurtenances thereof unto the said John Rogers his heirs or assigns forever together with all profits common or other advantages thereunto whatsoever also the reversion and reversions remain'd and to be made of the said land and premises above mentioned and every part thereof also all the whole right title interest claim & demand whatsoever of the said Tho^s Turner his wife their heirs &c for and to the said land & premises and the said Tho^s Turner & Patience his wife
