This Indenture made this 30th day of Decem^r in the year of our Lord 1794 Between the Right & Judith Rogers his wife of the county of White State of N^o Carolina of the one part Henry Smith of the county of Southampton & State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Rogers & Judith his wife for & in consideration of the sum of five hundred forty five pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Henry Smith the receipt whereof the said John Rogers & Judith his wife both hereby acknowledging both given granted bargain'd sold and conveyed by these presents with give grant bargain'd sell conveyance Possessⁿ & confirm unto the said Henry Smith his heirs forever a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the State of Virginia lying and being in the county of Southampton aforesaid & containing five hundred & thirty nine & three fourths Aers and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a white oak standing in the line then running North 15 degrees East 126 feet to a red oak then North 34 degrees East 90 Poles to a corner in the line then South 65 degrees East 53 feet to a pine then North 33 degrees East 230 Poles to a gum in the line then South 3 degrees East 360 Poles a long line of marked trees to a branch to a gum of the river then down the gut 60 degrees East 30 Poles to the river then up the various courses to the first station To have & hold the tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said Henry Smith his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Rogers & Judith their heirs & assigns doth hereby covenant & agree to and with the said Henry Smith his heirs & assigns that the said John Rogers & Judith his wife their heirs Executors Administrators shall build warrant & give defend unto the said Henry Smith his heirs and assigns the said land & Premises with the appurtenances aforesaid unto him or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day & year first above written

Therefore we do give to you or any two or more of you power to receive the acknowledgment which the said Judith Rogers shall be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture which is hereunto annexed And we do therefore command you to go personally to the said Judith Rogers and receive her acknowledgment of the same & likewise her power to be had from her said husband whether she has executed the said deed fully & voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of her husband & whether she is willing the said Indenture should be recorded
