Williams. And before the delivery of the said Negros and the said Samuel Stephenson do and will at this time and at all times hereafter and defend the right and title of the above negros Hannah Isaac Rachel & Sarah unto the said William Stephenson his heirs &c. his heirs & assigns forever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & the 7th day of June 1795.
