Colthrop to Brittle for diverse good causes & considerations but more especially for & in consideration of the sum of £4.10 Current money of Virginia being the within consideration mentioned and of the receipt of which money of said sum I do acknowledge and thereof acquit & discharge the said John Brittle his heirs & assigns & by these presents do relinquish release and forever quit all claim to the said John Brittle his heirs & assigns administrators and assigns of or to any right of dower or other property interest claim or demand which I now have or may hereafter have in a certain plantation tract or parcel of land containing 425 acres more or less situate lying & being in the county of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as is expressed in a deed from my husband Anthony Colthrop before mentioned to Richard Blow which has been duly proved and recorded in the court of the county of Southampton aforesaid & by the said Richard Blow sold & conveyed to W^m Brittle who left the same to his son John Brittle partly to these presents whose tenure & occupation the said land now is In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 13th day of December 1794
