This Indenture made this 11<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord 1756 Between  
 John Williams of the county of Southampton and parish of Nottoway of the one part and  
 Giles Wester of the county and parish aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said  
 John Williams for and in consideration of the just full sum of fifty pounds current  
 money of Virginia by the said Giles Wester to him in hand by him the undersaid & delivery  
 of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Williams doth hereby acknowledge &  
 thereupon acquit & discharge the said Giles Wester his heirs & assigns forever & himself therewith  
 fully and intirely satisfied contented and paid he the said John Williams hath  
 granted bargain'd sold alien'd enfeoff'd releas'd set over deliver'd & confirm'd by these  
 presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff releas set over deliver & confirm unto the  
 said Giles Wester and to his heirs and assigns forever all that Plantation messuage tract  
 and parcel of Land whereon the said John Williams now lives situate lying & being in  
 the county of Southampton & parish of Nottoway aforesaid containing by estimation 100 acres  
 be the same more or less and being part of a tract granted to Arthur Williams by letters  
 Patent bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of July 1745 and by him Transferred to Thomas Fishely  
 deed bearing date in June 1751 who sold & convey'd the same to John Blythe by Indenture  
 bearing date the 13 of January 1763 and the said John Blythe sold and convey'd the  
 aforesaid one hundred acres to John Blythe junr who by his certain deed of Indenture bearing  
 date the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ sold & convey'd the same unto the aforesaid John Williams  
 bounded & described as by the said John Blythes deed to the aforesaid John Williams  
 is expressed and declared and all the houses outhouses edifices buildings woods wais waters  
 and water courses gardens orchards Low grounds profits commodities hereditaments &  
 Appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining the curruer  
 and reversion rents & Issues & profits thereof and all the estate right title interest claim  
 and demand of him the said John Williams for and to the same every part &  
 parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Plantation messuage tract and parcel  
 of 100 acres Land and premises with all and every of the appurtenances aforesaid unto  
 him the said Giles Wester and to his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use &  
 behoof of him the said Giles Wester his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Williams  
 for himself his heirs heirs admors and assigns the said Plantation messuage tract &  
 parcel of One Hundred acres of land and premises with the appurtenances aforesaid  
 unto him the said Giles Wester and to his heirs and assigns forever against him  
 the said John Williams and against his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns  
 and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever claiming or demand  
 ing the same or any part or parcel thereof shall and well warrant & defend de  
 fend by these presents In Witness whereof the said John Williams hath here
