The commonwealth of Virginia to Robert Mealy & Bery^r Blunt Justices of the peace of the county of Southampton greeting. Whereas William Little & Elizabeth his wife have by their certain indenture of bargain & sale bearing date the 3^d day of November 1793 sold & conveyed unto James Lundy the fee simple estate of and in one certain tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances lying and being in the county aforesaid & containing by a late survey eighty one half acres of land, and whereas the said Elizabeth cannot conveniently travel to the court of our said county to make acknowledgment thereof, we therefore give unto you or any two or more of you power to receive the acknowledgment which the said Elizabeth may be willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said indenture which is hereto annexed and we do therefore command you that you do personally go to the said Elizabeth & receive her acknowledgment of the same & examine her in writing and a part from her said husband whether she doth the same freely & voluntarily without his persuasion or threats and whether she is willing the same should be recorded in the court of our said county. And when you have received her acknowledgment and examined her as aforesaid that you distinctly & plainly certify us thereof in our said court under your hands & seals sending them thro' the said indenture and this writ Witness Samuel Kello clock of our said court at his office the 1st day of Dec^r 1793 And in the 13th year of the commonwealth
