

Whereas Benjamin Miller of the county of Southampton hath this day made a purchase of a negro man slave name Jeffry, Twelve head of cattle, nine head of Sheep, one Horse, four feather beds & furniture, two walnut Tables, ten walnut chairs, one beautiful furniture, 1 Loom & Harney, one copper kettle, one Iron Pot, 1 Cart wheel, one Chest, one Trunk, the property of Sarah Miller. Now know all by these presents that I Sarah Miller for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred & thfourty dollars to me in hand paid by the said Benj^a Miller the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained, sold delivered & by these presents do absolutely bargain sell & deliver unto the said Benjamin Miller the aforesaid Negro man slave Jeffry 12 head of cattle, 9 head of Sheep, 1 Horse, 4 feather beds & furniture, 2 Walnut tables, 10 walnut chairs, 1 beautiful furniture, 1 Loom & Harney, 1 Copper kettle, 1 Iron pot, 1 Cart wheel, 1 Chest & 1 Trunk to have and to hold the said Negro man slave 12 head of cattle, 9 head of Sheep, 1 Horse & 4 feather beds & furniture 2 Walnut Tables, 10 walnut chairs, 1 beautiful furniture 1 Loom & Harney, 1 Copper Kettle, 1 Iron Pot, 1 Cart wheel, 1 Chest & 1 Trunk, to him the said Benj^a Miller his heirs Executors administrators or assigns forever & I the said Sarah Miller for myself my heirs Executors administrators do covenant & agree that aforesaid Negro man slave 12 head of cattle 9 head of Sheep, 1 Horse, 4 feather beds & furniture, Two walnut Tables, 10 walnut chairs, 1 beautiful furniture, 1 Loom & Harney, 1 Copper kettle, 1 Iron Pot, 1 Cart wheel, 1 Chest, 1 Trunk, unto the said Benj^a Miller his heirs Executors administrators assigns against the lawfull claim & demand of all persons whatsover to warrant & sure defend by these presents In Witness whereof the said Sarah Miller her hand & seal have herunto subscribed & set this 3 day of March in the year of our Lord Christ 1795 in the 15th year of the American Independence
