

This Indenture made this 9th day of August 1795 Between William Spencer of the county of Southampton
 and state of Virginia of the one part & David Spencer of the same County & State of the other part witnesseth that the
 the W^r Spencer bound in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Virginia money to him in hand paid
 by the said David Spencer at or before the sealing & delivering of this present instrument the receipt whereof the 2^d William
 Spencer doth hereby acknowledge &tho^t he acquit & discharge the said David Spencer his heirs & assigns from all
 demands he the said William Spencer have granted bargained sold alredy released & confirmed by the
 presents to grant bargain sell all release & confirm unto the said David Spencer his heirs & assigns from the
 al the right the said William Spencer holds in a tract or parcel of land lying on the south side of Mottley river about
 D. 1802 aforesaid tract beginning at a Maple a corner tree of Stephen Hancock & Indiana Edwards line then a north
 E. North East cast by a line of mark & trees of the said Edwards's to a small turkey oak a corner tree of the Edwards's &
 Rockhill's line thence by a line of mark & trees bearing a south east course to a large white oak on the Nattygag
 Dick's swamp and thence up the various courses of the said swamp to the beginning by estimation 100 rods
 together with all houses & offices buildings wood & underwood, his way water watercourses low grounds meadows, with
 commodities hereditaments & appurtenances belonging to the said plantation tract or parcel of land & premises belonging
 in any ways appertaining To have & hold thousand & Plantation tract or parcel of land & premises to the said William
 Spencer & his heirs & assigns from & to the said William Spencer his heirs & assigns
 I also do truly covenant & grant to and with the said David Spencer his heirs & assigns in manner
 fore following that is to say that the said David Spencer his heirs & assigns shall enjoy at all times here
 after peaceably have hold & occupy & possess & enjoy all & singular the 300 acres of land & premises aforesaid
 mentioned with appurtenances without the let trouble hindrance molestation or denial of delivery, better or worse
 whatsoeuer & further that the said William Spencer & his heirs claiming or to claim by from or under them any
 thing in the premises above mentioned or any part thereof shall and will from time to time & at all times here
 after upon the reasonable request & at the cost charge of the said David Spencer his heirs & assigns make and
 execute or cause to be executed every such further & other lawful & reasonable act & thing being
 devised & conveyances in the law whatsoever for the further better title & more perfect grant & conveying & giving of
 E. North all & singular the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said David Spencer his
 heirs & assigns as by the said William Spencer his heirs & assigns or his or their executors or administrators
 lawfully divided & assessed or required And lastly that the said William Spencer his heirs & assigns
 premises & every part & parcel thereof unto the said David Spencer his heirs & assigns against the last full
 Title & demands of all owners, person & persons whatsoever shall have warrant & process dependency the
 parents In witness whereof the said William Spencer hath to these presents set his hand &
