This Indenture made this 28th day of September in the year our Lord Christ 1795 between Amos Harris of the county of Southampton Parish of Litch of the one part & John Mecom of the aforesaid County & Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Amos Harris for the consideration of the sum of Twenty four pounds of good lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid on or before the sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said Amos Harris doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold aliened & confirmed unto the said John Mecom & to his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing fifty seven acres it being willed to the said Harris in his fathers last will and Testament bearing date fifteenth day of July 1785 And bounded as followeth to wit beginning at a pine a corner in William Wrights line thence along his line South 17 degrees West 133 pds to a Maple in the run of Georges branch thence down the run of the branch 132 pds to the mouth of the Spring Meadow thence up the run of the said Meadow 47 pds to a pine stump in head of said Meadow thence along line of new mark 2 to the beginning & have and to hold the said 57 acres of land with all its appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said John Mecom his heirs & assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof of the said John Mecom his heirs & assigns forever and the said Amos Harris doth for himself & his heirs covenant & agree with the said John Mecom his heirs & assigns that the said Harris his heirs heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend the above mentioned land & premises unto the said John Mecom his heirs & assigns forever against the claim or title of all person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the said Amos Harris hath hereunto set his hand & affixed his seal the day & year above written
