

This Indenture made this 11 day of September in the year of our Lord 1795 between Jacob Darden jun^r / Esq^r of Nisha Darden deed / of Southampton county & State of Virginia of the one part & John Birdsong of the county & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said John Birdsong hath for a certain consideration purchased of John Croslin Sen^r a part of a tract of land bounded as & deed made by said Croslin his wife to said Birdsong for the same / for which the said Nisha Darden obtained a Mortgage bearing date 14th February 1786 which Mortgage hath never been redeemed by said Croslin. Now the said Jacob Darden jun^r as Esq^r for & in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds to him in hand paid by said John Birdsong before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Jacob Darden doth hereby acknowledge himself therewith satisfied & contented doth release and confirm unto the said John Birdsong all his right Wills to that part of the above recited tract of land for which he hath obtained a deed of said Croslin & wife as aforesaid and the said Jacob Darden as Esq^r doth & will warrant and forever defend the said bargained premises with the appurtenances against the lawful claim of all and every person whatsoever by virtue of the Mortgage aforesaid To him the said John Birdsong his heirs & assigns forever To HAVE and to hold the said bargained premises with the appurtenances (as specified in said deed from Croslin Sen^r & wife) to him the said John Birdsong his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use benefit & behoof of him the said John Birdsong his heirs & assigns forever & he the said Jacob Darden as Esq^r his heirs & assigns doth & will forever warrant & forever defend the said bargained premises against the lawful claim of all and every person whatsoever by virtue of the said mortgage In Witness whereof the said Jacob Darden hath hereunto set his hand & seal this day & date first above written
