This Indenture made this 6th day of January in the year of our Lord third 1796 Between
Thomas Edmunds of the county of Southampton of the one part & W^m & Edmunds of the county
aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Edmunds for & in consideration
of the sum of £687. 10^s current money of Virginia to him in hand paid before the creating
& delivery hereof by the said W^m & Edmunds the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknow-
ledge & himself fully contented satisfied & paid hath given bargain & sold stand on
release conveyed & confirmed by these presents doth for himself his heirs & assigns
fully & absolutely give grant bargain & sell alien release convey
& fully confirm unto the said W^m & Edmunds his heirs & assigns for
ever two certain tracts or parcels of land situate lying & being in the county of South-
ampton aforesaid on the North side of Nettoway River the first containing by a
late survey 783 acres & bounded by the line of ^{the} Apammonk Indians formerly now the
order of M^r Nail's Carquans branch & by the lines of Ferry Olden Britain Scarborough and
Moody Collier the Ferry bridge branch the Apammonk Swamp & Nettoway River the
other seat tract or parcel of land contains 170 acres & bounded as follows beginning at a
butternut on the North side of Boxoro swamp formerly a corner of W^m Edmunds & the
Edmunds thence by the said Edmunds line North 70° Pole to a pine thence North
70 degrees west 105° Pole to a live oak thence North 62° Pole to a red oak thence
East 60° Pole to a pine thence East North East 88° Pole to a red oak thence North
East 28° Pole to a black oak a corner of W^m Scarboroughs land then by Scarboroughs
line south 60 degrees East 84° Pole to a black oak then south 50 degrees East 48° Pole
to a Gum by the side of Boxoro swamp aforesaid & down the various courses of the river
of the said swamp to the beginning at the swamp & thence the various courses of the
main river & vents of the said premises every part thereof and all the
estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Thomas
Edmunds and to the said seats tracts or parcels of land every part thereof & conveyed
to hold the said seats tracts or parcels of land & all & singular the premises above men-
tioned every part thereof & conveyed unto the said W^m & Edmunds
