together with the plantation utensils for the plantation on the North side of Mathey
River To have and to hold the said Negroes & their increase together with the
increase stock of horses hogs cattle & sheep with the plantation utensils as before mentioned
to the said Ethelred Edmonds and his heirs & assigns forever against the claim &
of one or more or any person or persons who to come In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand & seal this 6 day of January One thousand seven hundred
& Ninety six
