This Indenture made this 13th day of November 1795 Between John Mackie & Hannah his wife & William Mackie of the county of Southampton & Parish of Malloway of the one part and Edward Griffin of the county & Parish afore said of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Mackie & Hannah his wife and William Mackie for and in consideration of the just & full sum of four pounds current money of Virginia by the said Edward Griffin to them in hand paid before the executing & delivery of this present the receipt whereof the said John Mackie & Hannah his wife & William Mackie doth fully acknowledge & there acquit and discharge the said ~~Edw~~ Edward Griffin his heirs & assigns forever as & themselves therewith fully and entirely satisfied contented & paid say the S^r John Mackie & Hannah his wife & William Mackie Have granted bargain'd sold alien'd or possess'd released sit out deliver'd & confirm'd say their presents doth grant bargain'd sell alien infest and confirm unto the said Edward Griffin & his heirs & assigns forever all that messuage tract & parcel of land situated lying & being in the county of Southampton & Parish of Malloway afore s^d & being part of that Plantation tract of land wherein the s^d John Mackie now lives containing by estimation ^(more or less) and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at a Post oak a corner tree of Christy's line thence a line of marked trees to a Spanish oak a corner tree of Mr. Shivers line thence the main road to a white oak a corner tree ^{in the} said Shivers line thence a line of marked trees to a red oak a corner tree in the said Bay ^{Christy's line} thence a line of marked trees to the beginning and all the houses outhouses & appurtenances buildings wood ways water courses roads low grounds swamps marshes pastures feedings emblements profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances what soever to the same belonging or in anywise belonging & the reversion & remainder remain'd & remainders rents issues & profits thereof and the estate right title interest claim of them the said John Mackie & Hannah his wife & William Mackie
