

whereas by an act of General Assembly of Virginia entitled an act concerning the Nottoway tribe of Indians passed the 12th day of November anno Domini 1792 James Wilkinson John T. Blow Thos Vaughan Jas Miller Thomas Ridley and Robert Goodwin Gent. were appointed trustees of the said Indians and by the said act it was made lawful for the said tribe of Indians under the direction & with the approbation of the said trustees or any five of them to sell upon Credit a tract of land lying in the said county which had been leased to certain persons in the year 1779 which lease was about to expire in the year 1793 upon such sale the said trustees or any five of them were authorized & empowered to join the said Indians in conveying the same to the person or purchasers in fee. Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Indians & the said James Wilkinson Thomas Vaughan James Miller John T. Blow Thomas Ridley & Robt. Goodwin Gent. Trustees as aforesaid joining with the said Indians for and in consideration of the sum of £100 to be paid to the said trustees or their successors by the aforesaid Miles Cary for the payment whereof the said Cary has given bond with approved security pursuant to the above recited act have bargained & sold a certain tract of land with appurtenances thereto do bargain & sell & confirm to the said Miles Cary his heirs and assigns forever one tract or parcel of land being a part of the said tract mentioned in the above recited act containing by estimation 26 acres bounded as follows viz Beginning on the edge of the low grounds of the buckhorn swamp on the West side of the swamp at the buckhorn bridge thence along the Buckhorn road to a Hickory a corner tree in the line of N 2° E thence along the line of N 2° E to the Bear Creek branch thence down the various courses of the bed of the said branch to buckhorn swamp & up the edge of the low grounds of buckhorn swamp to the beginning on the aforesaid West side of the swamp together with the profits & advantages hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land or parcel of land in any wise belonging To have and to hold the said tract of land to the said Miles Cary to him and his heirs forever & the said Indians for themselves & their posterity the said tract of land & premises against themselves & their posterity & against all and every other person & persons whatsoever to the said Miles Cary his heirs by these presents so & shall warrant & you defend & the trustees the said tract of land & premises against themselves & against all and every other person or persons having under them or any of them to the said Miles Cary his heirs by these presents do and shall warrant & you defend An Testimony whereof we the parties to the presents have hereunto set our hands & affixed our seals the day & year above written.
