This Indenture made this 8th day of November in the year of our Lord Christ 1795
 Between William Pope of the county of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part and
 Briton Barnes of the county of State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that this
 William Pope for and in consideration of the sum of fifty seven pounds current money
 of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Briton Barnes the receipt whereof the
 said William Pope doth hereby acknowledge he the said William Pope hath granted
 bargained & sold alured & confirmed they their heirs do grant bargain & sell share & confirm
 unto the said Briton Barnes his heirs and assigns forever one feat tract or parcel of land
 situate lying within in the south side of Nottingham River in the county of Southampton a parcel
 containing 58 1/2 acres be the same more or less bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a small
 pine corner of Isaac Pops in the old Indian line thence North 52 degrees West 60
 pole to a small pine then North 45 degrees East 60 pole to a pine stump thence a straight line
 to a small Mulberry standing on the south side above said road thence up the road to
 Gray's ranch up the said branch to the old Indian line along the said line to the beginning
 Val the division & divisions remainder & remainders unto James & James of the said
 whatever of him the said William Pope for and to the said feat tract or parcel
 of land & every part thereof To have and to hold the said feat tract or parcel of land
 & Val Virginia the premises a bon mortuori & every part & parcel thereof with the appur
 tenances unto the said Briton Barnes his heirs and assigns forever to the only pro
 priety & behoof of the said Briton Barnes his heirs and assigns & the said William
 Pope for himself and his heirs the said feat tract or parcel of land & the premises & every
 part thereof against him & his heirs and against all and every person or persons
 whatsoever to the said Briton Barnes his heirs & assigns forever shall and will
