This Indenture made this 17th day of August in the year of our Lord 1795 between
Thomas Brittle of the county of Southampton of the one part & James Gray of the county
aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Tho. Brittle for & in consideration
of the sum of £13.0 current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Gray
before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Tho. Brittle
doth hereby acknowledge and thereof doth fully clearly & absolutely acquit warrant &
discharge the said James Gray his heirs & assigns by these presents for divers other
good causes & considerations him thereto moving to the said Tho. Brittle hath granted
bargained sold aliened conveyed & confirmed by these presents for himself his heirs
& assigns doth grant bargain sell alien convey & confirm unto the said James Gray his
heirs & assigns forever. All that Mesuage sit tract or parcel of land situate lying
and being in the county of Southampton aforesaid containing by estimation & estimate
the same more or less it being a tract or parcel of land purchased by the said Tho. Brittle
of Amos Washington and bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a pine tree near
the road leading from Broadwater bridge to Southampton with the same as corner to the
Amos Washingtons line thence by a line of marked trees to the scrubby creek ^{branch}
thence up the various courses of the said branch to a pine in the head of the said
branch then along a line of marked trees to a corner tree of the said Amos Washingtons
& Benj^m Branches & James Grays lines then along a line between the said Benj^m
& Amos Washingtons to a point from thence a straight line across to the beginning and so
all this wood underwoods & profits common to the said Amos Washingtons & Benj^m Branches
whatsoever to the said mesuage sit tract or parcel of land belonging or in any way
appertaining also the several & several messuages & messuages situate
of the said premises in and of every part and parcel thereof and all the estate right title
Interest claim and demand whatsoever of the said Tho. Brittle his heirs & assigns
