 1801 12th money of Virginia to them in hand paid John Whitehead the receipt whereof the said
 to be for Etheldred Brantly & wife doth truly acknowledge have granted bargained & sold by these presents
 unto the bargain grant & wife unto the said John Whitehead his heirs & assigns forever one certain
 tract parcel or divided of land situate lying & being in the county of Southampton con-
 taining by estimation 135 Acres more or less and bounded as follows beginning a Spring line
 in Mushwhite branch thence along a line of mast & trees & from thence to a Pecanew
 line thence to a white oak & to another white oak at Whiteoaks Swamp then to the said
 Swamp to Mushwhite branch & up the said branch to the beginning together with all houses
 orchards woods underwoods timber ways waters water courses privileges profits common
 & appurtenances to the said land & premises belonging or in any way appertaining thereto
 with the reversions remainder & Remainders together with the rents & profits of the said land
 & premises To have and to hold the said granted land & premises to him the said John
 Whitehead his heirs & assigns forever to the only proper use & behoof of him the said John Whitehead
 his heirs & assigns forever and the said Etheldred Brantly for herself & his heirs doth
 covenant and agree to and with the said John Whitehead that he the said Whitehead
 his heirs and assigns shall forever at all times forever hereafter peaceably & quietly lawfully
 use occupy enjoy the said land & premises free from all former gifts sales mortgages mortgages
 down or any other incumbrance of any nature or kind whatsoever & the said Etheldred
 Brantly for herself his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant and forever defend to the said John
 Whitehead all the right title which he or any manner claims by the descent & his
