This Indenture made the 2nd day of June in the year of our Lord 1795 between
Thomas Carroll of the state of North Carolina in the county of Halifax of the one part &
Arthur Dales of the state of Virginia & County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth
that the said Tho. Carroll for and in consideration of the sum of £50 Lawd money of Eng^l
to him in hand paid by the said Arthur Dales at or before the sealing & delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof the said Thomas Carroll doth hereby acknowledge & him of
therewith to be fully satisfied and paid & thereof doth clearly acquit & discharge the said
Arthur Dales his heirs heirs assigns & assigns forever by these presents hath given
granted bargained sold Enfeoffed & confirmed & by these presents doth give grant bargain
sell Enfeoff and confirm unto the said Arthur Dales his heirs & assigns forever one cer-
tain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the county of Southampton aforesaid con-
taining by Estimation 150 Acres be the same more or less such lands descended to said
and myself Thomas Carroll by & from Tho. Carroll decd by virtue of a will and become
as followeth Viz^t Beginning at a Baytree on the south side of the Tarpeen branch thence
along a line of marked trees to a black oak a corner thence Eastward thence along a dividing ditch
a certain tract of land as formerly divided Hugh Baskins & Rich^d Hanning's two parts
a corner tree growing in the head of the meadow branch Eastward thence down the run of
the said branch to Tarpeen branch thence along the various corners of the said Tarpeen
branch to the first Station may appear together with all orchards, woods, outhouses
Barren yards gardens woods underwood water & watercourses thereon standing growing
& being together with all profits commodities advantages emolument & appurtenances to
the same belonging or in anywise appertaining & also the reversion & remainder
