This Indenture made this 29th day of October Anno Domini 1795 Between
 John Lewis of the county of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part William
 Churchlow of the aforesaid county of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth
 that the said John Lewis for the consideration of the sum of one hundred and
 fifty pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand paid the receipt where-
 of hath been by the said John Lewis acknowledged hath bargained & sold
 by these doth bargain and sell unto the said William Churchlow his heirs
 and assigns all his right & title to a certain lot or parcel of land lying & being
 in the aforesaid county of Southampton and parish of Nottoway, granted to a
 certain Henry Adams by the court of the said county on the second Thursday in
 June 1787 for and during & unto the full end of 21 years from thence next immedi-
 ately ensuing & following & by the said Henry Adams sold to a certain John Wright
 by Indenture of bargain & sale bearing date the 13 day of October 1791 duly proved
 & recorded in the said court of Southampton and by the said John Wright sold
 to the within John Lewis party to these presents by Indenture of bargain & sale
 bearing date the 13 of February 1795 duly proven & recorded in the said court to-
 gether with all the profits privileges & appurtenances whatsoever to the premises
 belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said lot or parcel
 of land with the appurtenances as aforesaid to the said William Churchlow
 his heirs & assigns untill the full expiration of the above mentioned term of
 years & the said John Lewis for himself doth hereby depose & warrant the said
 title unto the said William Churchlow In Witness whereof ~~the said~~ the said
 John Lewis have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the day & year past
 above written

 and void the said James Uzzell hath granted bargained sold enfeoffed
