This Indenture made this 25th day of August in the year of our Lord Christ 1795 Between John Wright & Sarah his wife of the County of Kent & State of Eng^l of the one part & Josiah Vick of the same County & State of Eng^l of the other part Witnesseth that the s^r John Wright & Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of £100 Current money of Eng^l to them in hand paid by the s^r Josiah Vick at & before the signing sealing & delivery of these Presents doth the said John Wright & Sarah his wife doth hereby acknowledge & themselves therewith fully & peacefully contented & have bargain'd & sold & by these Presents doth hereby bargain & sell all & every part & parcel unto the said Josiah Vick his heirs & assigns a certain lot or lots of land & lying & being situate in the Town of Jerusalem in the said County of Kent & State of Virginia & distinguished by the Surveyors Plan of the said Town by the s^r (two, thus 2) bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning on the main Street thence running on the county land to the River thence down the River 105 feet 4 inches to the
