The commonwealth of Virginia To John Rogers and Robert Mabry, gentlemen greeting Whereas William Little and Elizabeth his wife have by their certain indenture dated the fifth day of September 1790 the said and conveyed unto James Sunday of the ^{county} of Sussex the fee simple estate of and in one certain tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances lying and being in the county of said and containing by late survey Twenty three Acres Land and whereas the said Elizabeth cannot conveniently travel to the court of our said county to make acknowledgement thereof We therefore give unto you or any two or three of your power to become the acknowledgement which the said Elizabeth maybe willing to make before you of the conveyance aforesaid contained in the said indenture which is hereto annexed and we do therefore Command you that you do personally go to the said Elizabeth and receive her Acknowledgement of the same and examine her freely and apart from her said husband whether she doth the same freely and voluntarily without his persuasion or threats of her said husband and when you shall receive her acknowledgement and examined her aforesaid that you distinctly & plainly certify us thereof in our said Court under your seals among them The said indenture and this writ witness And I do hereby command you to do this at her office the 20th day of July 1791 and in the 16th year of the commonwealth.
