At a court held for the said county of Southampton on the 11th day of June 1795 This Indenture was further proved by the oath of Thomas Curtis Buttrick another witness thereto and continued for a third witness. And at a court held for the above mentioned county on the 9th day of June 1796 This Indenture was fully proved by the oath of John E. Cooper a third witness thereto and with a commission for the private examination of Elizabeth Little and certified of the execution thereof ordered to be recorded

This Indenture made this day of in the year of Christ one thousand hundred and ninety six between Samuel Kello of the County of Southampton of the one part and Robert Shield of the county aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Samuel Kello for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to him in hand paid by the said Robert Shield the receipt whereof the said Samuel Kello doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Robert Shield his heirs executors and administrators for ever hath granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Robert Shield his heirs and assigns an certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Southampton and parish of Netoway containing by estimation one Acre be the same more or less and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at the main road on Williams Washingtons line at the corner of his fence Thence up the road S. W. to a small pine 38 yds from thence near S. E. to a small, thence to a red oak thence to another red oak thence to a pine and from thence to a post oak a line tree in the said Robert Shields land in a small dry brook 140 yds thence nearly N. E. to a corner tree near Williams Washingtons fence a corner tree between the said Williams Washington and Robert Shield thence N. W. along Washingtons line to the main road or post station and also all houses out houses ways waters and all services profits commodities and opportunities to the same belonging or in any way appertaining and thereunto and reversions remainders and remunerations unto heirs and profits thereof and of every part thereof and all the estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of him the said Samuel Kello of in and to the same or any part thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and premises hereby granted bargained and sold unto the said Robert Shield his heirs and assigns forever to only possess and enjoy of him the said Robert Shield his heirs and assigns And the said Samuel Kello for himself his heirs executors and administrators doth hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said Robert Shield his heirs executors and administrators that the said tract or parcel of
