Witnesseth that the said Job Wright for and in consideration of the just and full sum of ten pounds current money of Virginia by the said James Scott to him in hand paid the receipt whereof the said Job Wright doth hereby acknowledge and then of acquit and discharge the said James Scott his heirs and assigns forever and himself thenceforth fully and entirely satisfied and paid to the said Job Wright hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release deliver return and confirm unto the said James Scott and to his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation messuage tract or parcel of land which the said Job Wright now lives situated lying and being in the county of Southampton and parish of Stowaway containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less according to the survey ancient and reputed boundaries thereof and all the houses and houses subjects buildings
