 the time of executing this conveyance and that the said Jacob Turner his
 heirs and assigns shall and may at all times forever hereafter peacefully &
 quietly have hold occupy possess and enjoy the said premises with the appurte-
 nances free clear and discharged of and from any person or persons all manner
 of mortgages debts pledges and executions and all other incumbrances
 of what nature or kind soever and also that he the said John Martin and his
 heirs the said tract and parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances unto
 the said Jacob Turner his heirs and assigns against all and every person or
 persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same shall and will warrant
