This Indenture made this 3rd of February 1796 between Jesse Browne of the county of Mecklenburg of the one part, & James Browne of the county of Southampton of the other part witnesseth that Jesse Browne in behalf of himself his heirs &c. as for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds current money to him in hand paid by James Browne bargain sold transfer made over & deliver unto the sd James Browne his heirs &c. the whole and every part of all the land which the sd Jesse Browne is legally entitled to & doth inherit from his said father the late Doct. John Browne lying & being in Southampton on the south side of Rottoway river Gas Cornhill &c. &c. &c. are now appointed by the worshipful court of Southampton to divide the lands of the said doct among the heirs their divisions & allotment when they may execute the same by their return to court with fully pointed and described Jesse Browne part the sd Jesse Browne in behalf of himself his heirs &c. for & in consideration of the above sum of £200. as bargain sold & deliver the above mentioned instances to him the sd James Browne his heirs &c. to have & to hold forever. This Indenture made this 15th day of May 1796 Between John Browne and Martha Browne his wife of the one part & Abbigdon Browne of the other part (all the parties residing in the county of Southampton) Witnesseth that John Browne for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred & seventy pounds current money to him in hand paid by Abbigdon Browne the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath bargain sold relinquished & delivered and by these presents doth bargain sell relinquish & deliver to the sd Abbigdon Browne all his part or share of the land (lying on the south side of Rottoway River in the county of Southampton) which he inherits from his said father Doct John Browne, to have and to hold the said inheritable land
