This Indenture made this Nineteenth day, of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and ninety six; Between Thomas Eccitt & his wife Elizabeth Eccitt of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Exum Eccitt of the county & state aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Eccitt & wife Elizabeth for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten pounds Virginia currency to the said Thomas Eccitt & wife Elizabeth acknowledged by the said Exum Eccitt at or before the executing and delivery of these presents whereby the s^d Thomas Eccitt & wife Elizabeth both parties do hereby and do hereby grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, & confirm unto the s^d Exum Eccitt & to his heirs & assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land & premises with the appurtenances situate lying and being in the county of Southampton & state aforesaid containing by estimation about Ninety five acres better more or less & bounded as follows. To wit beginning at a dead pine a corner tree of Exum Eccitts line Jacob Barnetts and Nathan Britts and thence along the said Eccitts line to a white oak in the north prong of the little meadow branch thence across the run of the branch to the run of the great branch thence up the run of the said branch to the run of the great meadow thence up the run of the said branch to a Maple corner tree in Jacob Barnetts & Jacob Laurences line thence along the said line to the beginning To have and to hold with all the appurtenances to the said Exum Eccitt and his heirs forever In witness whereof the said Thomas Eccitt & wife Elizabeth hath affixed their hands and seals the day and year above written.
