This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of May in the year of Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between William Appa^hwhite of the county of Southampton of the one part & John Appa^hwhite of the 2^d county of the other part. Witnesseth that the said William Appa^hwhite for and in consideration of the just and full sum of one hundred and sixty seven pounds three shillings current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Appa^hwhite before the sealing & delivering of these presents the receipt whereof the said William Appa^hwhite doth hereby acknowledge having granted bargained sold & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell alien release & confirm unto the said John Appa^hwhite his heirs and assigns forever the following slaves, to wit: March 1st 1807
